<u>DPW Report:</u> We have been jetting sewers and started the Standpipe on Monday. We had to bypass the valve into the tank; water was coming out of the ground. Something broke in the ground; they took Decker's vac truck and sucked it out, Staab brought out a pump to help pump that out of the 22,000-gallon tank(thankfully we have a big enough tank). The guys are working 24 hours a day. If all goes well it will be ready to go on Wednesday afternoon and they can finish welding the outside as it is full. Thank you for putting all the hours in. Getting everything ready for winter. Green Grove has about half of their lot done. Sewer is done up there. They may have to do a little pond according to the DNR. We have put the wings on the plows for the winter and shut down the parks.

<u>Mayor's Report:</u> The mayor stopped and this is what he said: Mayor would like to put on the next Agenda in November that he would like to increase the per diem to \$10.00 more per meeting. The mayor also would like to investigate hiring an accounting firm to look into our accounts for us to see that we are doing everything correctly and maybe alleviate some of the paperwork.
