A Wilczek/Mauel motion and subsequent vote approved the minutes for the 11/13/18 council meeting.

Public Opinion:

Under Public Opinion: Dan Hooks again voiced his concerns. **Public Present:** Dan Hooks, Cindy Cardinal-OW Enterprise, Sandy Deacon-HOF, and Nicole Shattuck-Sentinel & Rural News

Amendment to Ordinance 10-1-28: Winter Parking:

A Jaffke/Mauel motion and subsequent vote approved the amendment to Ordinance 10-1-28: Winter Parking as noted: No parking on City streets between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m., November 15th to April 1st.

House of Friends Donation:

Sandy Deacon approached the Council on behalf of the House of Friends. A Wilczek/Martine motion and subsequent vote approved the \$3,000 annual donation.

Open Public Hearing for Consideration for Adoption 2019 Budget: Time: 7:15 p.m.

<u>Review/Consideration for Adoption of the 2019 Budgets for the following:</u>

City General \$1,093,248, Owen Water UT \$571,700, Owen Sewer UT \$423,300 and Owen Withee Police Commission \$224,572

Close Public hearing. Time: 7:35 p.m.

Consideration for Adoption of 2019 Budgets:

A Martine/Wagner motion and subsequent vote approved the 2019 budgets as submitted.

Committee Appointments:

A Mauel/Jaffke motion and subsequent vote approved the appointment of Joan Jalling to the Parks and Rec and Zoning Committees to occupy the seat vacated by Mike Renderman.

Resolution #2018-12 Petition to Establish Rail Crossing:

A Mauel/Martine motion and subsequent vote approved Resolution #2108-12 allowing the City to petition the Office of the Commissioner of Railroads for an investigation and order to approve the establishment of a new spur and crossing of Industiral Street for Quality Roasting Soybean Facility.

Qulaity Roasting Agreement-Rail Spur Funding:

A Wilczek/Jaffke motion and subsequent vote approved Quality Roasting Funding agreement as presented by CDC Director Tim Swiggum. Tim explained Volkman Railroad Builders would step forward to fund the \$600,000 project with the City paying back Volkman Roasting \$100,000 per year for 6 years from the TIF funds. This would not go against the City's borrowing capacity.

CDC Report

CDC Tim Swiggum reported that the he has been working mostly on the Quality Roasting Agreement and the Resolution to establish a rail crossing. Parks & Rec will be meeting Dec 6th at 6 p.m. at the Fire Hall with the Will Maki Fund Committee, Friends of the Old School, and Owen Public Housing to pursue

plans for Crowley park and surrounding area. A Martine/Wilczek motion and subsequent vote approved the CDC report.

Disbursements

A Wilczek/Jaffke and subsequent vote approved to pay disbursements of City Pooled Check #27894-279274. City \$24,915.50; Water \$1,810.52; Sewer \$4,310.35; TIF #3 \$375.00 and TIF #4 \$375.00.

Suggested items for future agendas:

Parks & Rec, OWPC report, Owen Jr Fair update, Water Meter Cards and status of computers, both under investigation.
