Nicole said she could do the layout, and have it printed in Marshfield. Nicole still has paper left from our previous calendar. Deadline is for autumn fest. (The 22<sup>nd</sup> of October?)

Trunk or treat: We will begin working on that on August 1<sup>st</sup>, to give us enough time to plan ahead.

Lorelee commented on a bill being brought to the legislature about teachers and libraries being held accountable for exposing kids to inappropriate material. WVLS is not responding at this time.
