1. Planning Committee was called to order at 3:35 pm. by Wilczek Zoning Committee was called to order at 3:35 pm by Jalling.

2. Roll call:

Planning Committee present were Bob Wilczek, John Mauel, Allen Gajewsky and Chad Smith-Director of Public Works.

Zoning Committee present were Joan Jalling, Darlene Zukowski, Dennis Lulloff, and Brandon Wilson- Zoning Administrator.

Others present. Teale Bohl, Tim Swiggum-Owen CDC, Cindy Cardinal- O-W Enterprise and Nicole Rogers- The Sentinel and Rural News.

3. Consideration to allow construction of a duplex at 700 E. 2nd St, Parcel # 265.0644.000:

After a short discussion including a report on neighbors who had voiced an opinion on the project. 2 neighbors had inquired but have no issues with the construction of a duplex where a trailer was previously.

Zoning Committee: A Lulloff/Zukowski motion/second to allow for a conditional use to construct a duplex at 700 E. 2nd St. passed unanimously.

Planning Committee: A Mauel/Smith motion/second to recommend to the council to allow construction of a duplex at 700 E. 2nd St. passed unanimously.

4. **Zoning Committee** was adjourned at 3:45 pm by Jalling.

4. Planning Committee:

Offer to Purchase 5 acres in the Agribusiness Park:

Sean Reed, Lead Superintendent for Casper Construction, has submitted an offer to purchase for 5 acres of land at the entrance to the Agribusiness Park. Discussion was held that the parcel has not been surveyed and would need a lot of fill to build it up enough to utilize for the storage of construction equipment. In the future he would like to build a building but the immediate need is for storage of construction equipment. The offer is for \$100 per acre.

Discussion was held concerning the price being too low without seeing an immediate tax base increase. It will require a lot of fill and it is likely going to require at least \$100,000 in fill to just make the lot usable. Concerns regarding the cost of the road and entry into the parcel were discussed and who would make these improvements.

A Gajewsky/Mauel motion and second to recommend that the council sell the **5 acres for \$2500 (500 per acre)**, buyer will be responsible for developing the entrance and roadway access and pay the closing costs and electric extension if required passed unanimously.

5. **Adjourn:** Wilczek adjourned the Planning Meetings at 4:15 pm.
