Snow and Ice Removal



Snow and ice must be removed from all sidewalks within 24 hours after a snowfall. If the sidewalk is not

cleared within this time period, the city may remove the snow and you will be billed for the removal. Please do not push snow into the street or alleys!!

Winter Parking

Parking is prohibited on any city street between November 15th and April 1st during the hours from 2:00 am and 6:00 am unless prior arrangements are made with City Hall.

Grass, Leaves and Weeds

Grass and weeds exceeding 8" inches in height shall be mowed by the property owner – if not the City will mow and charge the property owner.



DO NOT MOW YOUR GRASS OR RAKE YOUR LEAVES INTO THE STREET AS THEY PLUG UP THE SOTRM DRAINS!

Park Hours

All City Parks are closed between 10:00 pm and 6:00 am. City curfew will be enforced for anyone under 18 years of age. Curfew is from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am Sunday-Thursday and from 11:00 pm to 6:00 am Friday and Saturday.

Garbage Pickup

Garbage & recycling pickup is contracted through GFL Disposal Services. Please use your garbage and recycling carts provided. Garbage pickup is every Friday and recycling is every other Friday. It is recommended placing bins out the night before. If regular pickup falls on a holiday week, pickup will be on the following day. Please place your carts 4 feet from any obstacles such as other carts & mailboxes.

House Numbers

It is important to check that your house number is easily visible to emergency personnel. If you have questions, please contact City Hall or the Fire Department.

Dog Licenses

Dog licenses must be obtained by the owner of any dog 5 months of age or older. License must be paid by April 1st of each year or within 30 days of acquiring the dog. All dogs are required to have a current rabies vaccination and proof will be required for licensing.



Note: A limit of 5 animals per household. 3 dogs and 2 cats or 3 cats and 2 dogs but not 4 of either. Call City Hall with any questions

* If you feed a cat for three days you will be considered the owner *

Snowmobile/ATV/UTV Trails

The designated trail maps are available from the Owen City Hall. Please obey the safety rules and watch for traffic. Remember to be respectful to property owners along the trail.

Elections

Polling location is at the Owen City Hall – 833 W 3rd Street.

Local Spring elections are held the first Tuesday in April and the

State and Federal elections are the first Tuesday



after the first Monday in November. Remember that you will be required to provide Phot ID to vote. Register early at City Hall with Proof of Residence to save time on Election Day!!

Sewer/Water/Utility Bills

If you are selling or moving, you must contact City Hall for a final meter read.

The Owen Water Utility will be installing wireless meter readers 2021-2025.

Branch and Brush Pickup – FREE

1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month during Summer/Daylight Savings Time & the rest of the year/winter pickup will be ONLY the 1st Thursday of the month.

The City crew will pick up tree limbs and brush for FREE if the following applies:

- * 4" inches or less in diameter
- * less than a pick up load (4'X8')
- * cut ends toward the street at the curb edge



OR take down to the City Garage
Christmas Tree pickup on 1st and 3rd Thursday in January
