Snow and Ice Removal

Snow and ice must be removed from all sidewalks within 24 hours after a snowfall. If the sidewalk is not cleared within this time period, the city may remove the snow and you will be billed for the removal. Please do not push snow into the streets or alleys!!

Winter Parking

Parking is prohibited on any city street between November 15 and April 1 during the hours from 2:00 am and 6:00 am unless prior arrangements are made with City Hall.

Grass, Leaves and Weeds

Grass and weeds exceeding 8" in height shall be mowed by the property owner or the city will take care of it and charge the property owner. DO NOT MOW YOUR GRASS OR RAKE YOUR LEAVES INTO THE STREET AS THEY PLUG UP THE STORM DRAINS! Yard waste should be dumped at the compost site at the City Garage.

Park Hours

All City Parks are closed between 10:00 pm and 6:00 am. City curfew will be enforced for anyone under 18 years of age. Curfew is from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am Sunday-Thursday and from 11:00 pm to 6:00 am Friday and Saturday.

Ice Rink

The lighted Ice Skating area is on the Millpond and warming facilities are available. Please keep it clean!! Skates available at no charge and can be checked out at O-W Sports, 107 N. Central Ave.





Tax Payment COVID Updates: Please include a self addressed stamped envelope if you wish to have a receipt. Please plan to pay with a check or exact change via mail or the drop box.

Garbage Pickup

Garbage & recycling pickup is contracted through Express Disposal Services. Please use your garbage and recycling carts provided. Garbage pickup is every Friday and recycling is every other Friday. Please get it to the curb by 6am. If regular pickup falls on a holiday week, pickup will be on the following day.

House Numbers

It is important to check that your house number is easily visible to emergency personnel. If you are ever in need of emergency services you will be glad you made it easier for them to find you in your time of need. If you have questions please contact city hall or the fire department.

Dog Licenses

Dog licenses are DUE January 1st must be obtained by the owner of any dog 5 months of age or older. License must be paid by April 1 of each year or within 30 days of acquiring the dog. All dogs are required to have a current rabies vaccination and proof will be required for licensing. *If you feed a cat for three days you will be considered the owner. Note: A limit of 4 animals per household. 3 dogs and a cat or 3 cats and a dog but not 4 of either. Call with any questions.

Snowmobile/ATV/UTV Trails The designated trail maps are available from the Owen City Hall. Please obey the safety rules and watch for traffic. Remember to be respectful to property owners along the trail.






Good things to Know!

Elections

Election polling location is located at the Owen Public Library. Local Spring elections are held the first Tuesday in April and the State and Federal elections are the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November. Remember that you will be required to provide Photo ID

in order to vote. Register early at City Hall with Proof of Residence to save time on Election Day!!

Branch and Brush Pickup—FREE

1st and 3rd Thursdays of the month during Summer/Daylight Savings Time & the rest of the year/winter pickup will be ONLY the 1st Thursday of the month. The City crew will pick up tree limbs and brush for FREE if the following applies:

*4" inches or less in diameter

*less than a pick up load (4'X8')

*cut ends toward the street at the curb edge OR take down to the City Garage
